### Entry Requirements

### Mode of learning

The course shall be offered through weekend classes for practical skills competencies and during the week from Monday to Friday for theory. Independent research shall run concurrently with the taught courses. Face-to-face and online learning will be available.

- To equip trainee machinists with basic pattern understanding, cutting, and garment development skills in Zimbabwe;
- To impart various garment construction skills & methods to participants;
- To provide course participants with industrial machine operating skills;
- To train participants in drafting & developing an operation sequence breakdown;
- To produce a textile apparel entrepreneur.
