



NOTICE TO RETURNING STUDENTS

REGISTRATION REMINDER: FIRST SEMESTER 2026

1. Registration and Fees Payment

This is a reminder that normal registration is still open up to **17 March 2026**. To qualify to register, students must pay at least 60% of the total fees by then.

The late registration period shall run from 17 March 2026 to 30 March 2026. Late registration penalties shall apply as determined by the University from time to time.

Thereafter, no further registration extensions shall be granted. If you fail to register you are automatically deferred to the next semester.

2. Semester Progression

Students are expected to register progressively from one semester to the next. Skipping semesters or attempting irregular registration is not allowed.

Movement into a new semester or academic year is not automatic. It is governed strictly by electronically computed decisions generated upon the publication of your previous semester's results. You must view your results for the preceding semester before attempting to register for the next.

Your progression status is determined by your academic performance as captured in the system.

NB: Students who have not completed their registration are prohibited from attending classes and will not be allowed to sit for examinations at the end of the semester.

3. Students on Attachment

If a student is not registered during work related learning, her/his Faculty will not conduct site visits or provide academic oversight. Students cannot backdate their registration. If you miss the registration deadline for a semester, you cannot register for it later. Similar to taught courses, failing to register during the work related learning period means the academic progress will not be recognised, and the student is deferred.

4. Examinations

Examinations are scheduled to run from **18 – 27 May 2026**. Registered students who have also cleared the full fees balance will be allowed to take examinations. The full fees should have been paid by **30 April 2026**. Students are required to take note of this for planning purposes.

Results publication is anticipated on 30 June 2026.

5. 2026 Graduation Ceremony

The Women's University in Africa graduation ceremony shall be held on **30 October 2026**.

All graduands and instream students are required to confirm accuracy of their biodata as what is on your national identity card or passport should match what is in the system. If there are any discrepancies, please mail the Admissions Office on admissions@wua.ac.zw where irregularities are noted. Non correction of biodata attracts a certificate and/or transcript reprint fee as determined by the University from time to time.
