You can apply online at www.wua.ac.zw or alternatively, download the application form from the WUA website: www.wua.ac.zw and manually complete the form. Attach the proof of payment of the application fee and certified copies of a national ID card, birth certificate and educational certificates and submit the application form at the satellite campus of your choice.

You can also obtain the application form from the University upon payment of a non-refundable application fee as follows:

- US\$25 or equivalent at prevailing foreign exchange rate for undergraduate and postgraduate programmes for Zimbabwean applicants;
- USD65 (strictly foreign currency) for PhD programme applications; and
- US\$50 (strictly foreign currency) for international applicants.
