The Women's University in Africa Council and Senate wishes to notify the University community that the University's 22nd Graduation Ceremony will proceed as follows:

Time : All graduands and guests are expected to be seated by 0800 hours.

REHEARSALS

Rehearsals for the graduation shall proceed as follows:

Time : 1400 hours

All graduands must attend graduation rehearsals.

1.0 GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate, students must fulfil all of the following prerequisites:

1.1 Satisfaction of All Academic Requirements for Your Specific Programme

Prospective graduands must ensure they meet all academic requirements for their program to graduate. They can check their myHope portal to ensure their courses are in order, and any queries must be directed to their respective departmental chairpersons;

1.2 Clear All Outstanding Arrears

All graduands must clear any fee arrears on or before **30 September 2026**, as no payment plans will be entertained. All students must settle all fees well in advance of this deadline, as only paid-up students will be permitted to attend the graduation ceremony. 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1.3 Verification of Biodata

All students must verify the accuracy of their biodata to ensure all details are captured correctly for the production of academic documents.

Details to be verified include:

- **First Name(s) and Surname;**
- **Date of Birth; and**
- **Place of Birth.**

Students who identify any discrepancies or anomalies are requested to notify the Admissions Office by submitting a certified copy of their **Birth Certificate** to admissions@wua.ac.zw by **21 September 2026**.

This verification process is essential to ensure the **timely processing of transcripts and certificates**. Please note that once academic documents have been produced, the student will bear **any costs associated with reprinting due to incorrect information**, in accordance with University regulations.

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1.6 Dress Code

Gentlemen's preferred graduation attire is a dark-colored suit (black, grey, or navy blue) with a white shirt and a matching tie. Ladies should wear black, grey, or navy-blue skirts with white blouses or shirts. Bright-colored clothing, such as pink, yellow, orange, or lime green, is discouraged.

When choosing footwear, ladies should select heels that are comfortable enough for walking to and from the graduation podium.

2.0 COLLECTION OF ACADEMIC REGALIA AND INVITATION CARDS

Invitation cards and academic regalia shall be available for collection from all campuses from 19 – 26 October 2026. Thereafter, collection shall be done at the graduation venue at the Harare campus on 29 October 2026. At all collection points, the production of the clearance form and proof of payment for academic regalia and graduation, respectively, is mandatory.

3.0 GUESTS

Each graduand may invite only two (2) guests; extra guests will not be admitted, as entry into the graduation arena is strictly by invitation. **NO INVITATION CARD, NO ENTRY!!** In addition, a designated sitting area has been reserved for female graduands with children attending as their guests.

4.0 PHOTOGRAPHERS

Only accredited photographers, Gold Print and KayAfe shall be allowed into the graduation arena to take photographs for a fee upon prior arrangements with the graduands.

5.0 COLLECTION OF TRANSCRIPTS AND CERTIFICATES

Graduation transcripts and certificates shall be available for collection from Faculty representatives at the graduation venue. However, prior arrangements can be made to collect the transcript ONLY from 24 August 2026 upon production of a clearance form, Women's University in Africa Student Identity Card, and National Identity Card, Passport or Driver's Licence at the point of request.

The same terms and conditions apply to collection of the certificate and transcript at the graduation venue on 30 October 2026.
